

US to allow adoption from Vietnam for first time since 2008

After a six-year ban, US families will be able to adopt children from Vietnam beginning September 16, 2014. There had previously been concerns about unethical practices in Vietnam, and since the ban placed in 2008 the country has joined the Hague Convention, which has oversights and processes in place that focus on the protection of children and prevention of child buying.
